

Bodegas Muga

Bodegas Muga was officially founded in 1932 by the Muga family, who at that point had spent several decades working as viticulturists in Rioja Alta. The winery has legendary status due to its philosophy revolving around adherence to tradition, dynamism, and winemaking of the highest quality. It is also the only winery in Spain with their own master cooper. Every deposit and barrel at the winery is French oak made by the master cooper. As one of Rioja Alta's premier producers, the Muga family is unanimously considered to be one of Spain's most important winemaking families.

Varietal: 75% Tempranillo, 15% Mazuelo, 10% Graciano

Winemaking: The grapes are sorted extensively at the winery and undergo indigenous yeast fermentation in open top oak fermenters that are produced at the winery. The wine is transferred to French oak barrels following the primary fermentation.

Aging: 24 months in French oak, 18 of which are in 225L barriques produced at the winery and the other 6 months are spent in large oak vats also produced at the winery.

Torre Muga is a wine that shows the power a Rioja Alta wine can achieve, yet balanced with freshness of the high altitude mesoclimate of the vineyards located near the Oja-Tiron rivers.
