For the 2013 vintage, 10% of the volume was aged for 6 months in second use French oak, and the remaining 70% was kept in stainless steel tanks, stirring the lees once per week; this helps create a pleasant and drinkable wine characterized by a varied array of aromas. There is no a fixed process but a dynamic adaptation to the conditions of the harvest and the characteristics of the season.

Fresh, elegant and intense aromas of citrus and mineral notes. The palate is balanced and mineral edged with sharp acidity.

Fermentation was done in stainless steel tanks at 24° - 26°C. The wine was aged in 30% oak barrels for 7 to 9 months in 2nd and 3rd-use barrels during which the malolactic fermentation took place.
