**Brut****“88” Wine Spectator**

The particular pinot noir from the Montaudon vineyards, la Cote des Bars brings consistent power. Predominance of Pinot Meunier rounds the blend while chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine.
