Winemaking

The grapes are destemmed, cooled to 5-8°C and gently pressed. The must is then carefully raked and followed by a cold soaking at 3°C for 6 to 7 days to express all of its aromatic potential. Thermo-regulated alcoholic fermentation takes place in concrete vats or stainless steel tanks for 15-20 days. Aging on fine lees is done from the end of September through early January.

The delicacy of the Grenache combines with the softness of Tibouren creating a refreshing and well-balanced palate.
