	2012 Brut Classic <i>95pts – Wine Enthusiast</i>	459.95	367.96
	A 'classic' blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, a traditional and elegant showcase of the 2012 vintage with over three years on the yeast. It is 'brut' level dry and vintage in every sense of the word. Rich, creamy and delicious with precise, pinpoint bubbles.		
	2013 Wedding Cuvée <i>#18 The Enthusiast 100 Wines of 2017, 94pts – Wine Enthusiast</i>	454.95	363.96
	This is Iron Horse's most romantic bubbly, also known as "love potion". It is made from predominantly Pinot Noir and has a slight pink hue. You can debate whether it is a pale, golden Rose or a Blanc de Noirs.		
	2013 Russian Cuvée	459.95	367.96
	Russian Cuvée commemorates the style of Sparklings made for the historic Reagan-Gorbachev summit meetings, which ended the Cold War. This is the riches of the Iron Horse Sparklings, yet still technically brut level dry. An ideal toasting wine, it has been served at the White House for five consecutive presidential administrations.		
	2009 Ocean Reserve <i>90pts – Robert Parker</i>	471.95	377.56
	A special, limited edition, vintage Blanc de Blancs. Iron Horse gives \$4 a bottle to the National Geographic's Ocean Initiative, establishing marine protected areas and supporting sustainable fishing practices around the globe.		
	2007 Brut Rosé <i>93pts – Robert Parker</i>	559.95	447.96
	The most vivid and bold of the Iron Horse Sparklings both in terms of flavor and color. Made mostly from Pinot Noir, it is bright, full, quite dry with a soft, almost creamy mouthfeel. The gorgeous color comes from letting the Pinot Noir sit on the skins.		
	2016 Unoaked Chardonnay	289.95	226.50
	The Unoaked Chardonnay is a pure expression of cool, foggy Green Valley. The wine is remarkably elegant and full of bright acidity.		
	2013 Estate Chardonnay	329.95	263.96
	100% Chardonnay grapes were pressed as whole clusters, just as is done with sparkling wine. Frequent lees stirring or batonnage, at least three times a week for at least seven months contributes to the complex flavors.		
	2012 Estate Pinot Noir <i>88pts – Wine Enthusiast</i>	489.95	378.00
	Newly replanted vineyards, heightened wine making and the uniqueness of Green Valley Pinot Noir all come together in a truly gorgeous bottle of wine with raspberry, red cherry flavors, a very pretty, soft, ripe entry and a long silky finish.
