**Appellation:** Voor-Paardeberg

**Varietal:** 90% Marsanne, 10% Roussanne

**Alcohol:** 13.35% **TA:** 6.2 g/L **pH:** 3.32 **RS:** 3.1 g/L

**Winemaking:** Grapes were picked at lower sugar levels to ensure a crispy acidity. Whole bunch pressing helps to retain natural acidity. The wine was fermented in 500 L and 5000 L French oak barrels. It was aged in barrels for 8 months until blending and bottling took place.

**Tasting Notes:** White ginger flower, ripe tropical fruit and hints of vanilla. Good acidity helps the lingering mineral aftertaste.



### 2015 Cinsault

**Appellation:** Swartland

**Varietal:** 100% Cinsault

**Alcohol:** 12.74% **TA:** 5.0 g/L **pH:** 3.59 **RS:** 2.1 g/L

**Winemaking:** Grapes were picked at different sugar levels to ensure a good balance. Fermented with the skins on, with punching down and pumping over, as well as carbonic maceration to retain upfront fruit flavors. The wine was aged in 500 L and 5000 L French oak barrels for 6 months until blending and bottling took place.

**Tasting Notes:** An elegant and velvety wine with good color and concentration. Red berries and cherries with savory black olives and black spices.
