Winemaking: Hand-harvested and stored in small baskets. 60% fermentation by indigenous yeast in French oak puncheons and demi-muids and 40% fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

Aging: 8 months sur lie in the fermentation vessel with battonage

Winemaking: The grapes are hand harvested and sorted at the winery, then pressed and transferred to barrels for fermentation. The must is aged sur lie which adds a unique complexity and weight typical of the region. This wine is lightly filtered before bottling.

Aging: 12 months sur lie in French oak puncheons and demi-muids with battonage
