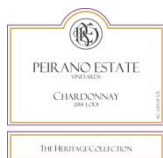

 The palate is filled with blueberries, ripe blackberries, prune, and figs.

 Red cherries, pomegranates and raspberries with a lingering hint of dried cherries. Bright red fruit tannins and good acidity.

 Lush flavors of ripe peaches, nectarines, Meyer lemons and stone fruit.



2015 Zinfandel Heritage Old Vines

Aging: French & American oak, 15% new
 Luscious, juicy, freshly-picked ripe strawberries, sweet black cherries, strawberry jam with moderate tannins.

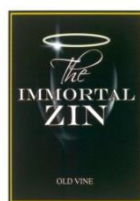


2015 Cabernet Sauvignon

Aging: French & American oak, 12% new. Racked every three months and topped every two weeks.
 Sweet black boysenberries, raspberries, juicy fruit and baked blackberry pie flavors with dry and firm, round tannins.



2014 Zinfandel Immortal Old Vines

Alcohol: 14.2%

Aging: 12 months in French & American oak, 15% new
 The palate is wrapped in a velvety mix of raspberry cordial, sweet mouth filling red fruit.



2016 Malbec

Alcohol: 13.8%

Aging: French & American oak, 12% new
 Flavors of black cherries, plums and pepper. Light spice, cassis and toast lead to a soft lingering



2016 Illusion Red Blend

Aging: French & American oak, 15% new
 The palate explodes with rich mouth-filling blackberries, juicy red cherries, plums, black raspberries and boysenberries
