








# RENWOOD

Established in 1993 in the Sierra Foothills, Renwood Winery is surrounded by the rolling hills and rushing streams of California's gold country. The estate vineyard is predominately planted with the Grandpere clone of Zinfandel in both head trained and trellised vines. Renwood wines reflect the skill of our winemakers and our devotion to the craft of winemaking.

 <b>2015 Zinfandel BBQ</b> 80% Zinfandel, 18% Petite Sirah, 2% Carignane    Alcohol: 14%    Aging: 10 months in oak Soft and plush on the palate and packed with fresh acidity, the wine has aromas of blackberry, cracked peppercorn and anise.
