

Saint Patrice

The roots of Saint Patrice date back to the 17th century. At that time the estate belonged to the daughter of one of the advisors of King Louis XIV. The following centuries shaped the Clos, its vines, and its wines. In 1838, Clos Saint Patrice was identified as «one of the best Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards» (in the directory 'L'annuaire de Vaucluse', 1838). Various writings confirm the reputation of the Clos, which was even described as «the oldest Châteauneuf-du-Pape cru» in the 1920s.

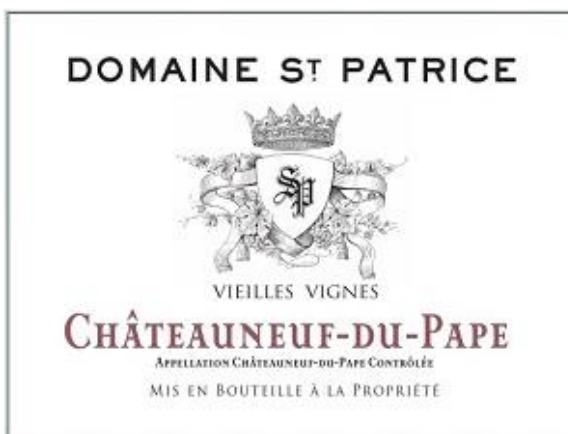
