"Governare" means adding slightly raised grapes (once Trebbiano, now Sangiovese) to the first new wine of the just completed harvest. This addition triggers off a second slow fermentation in 90 Hl barrels, which continues until the following spring. The process increases glycerin levels, softens and rounds out the wine without affecting its austerity and elegance.

Elegant and classy with intense notes of ripe cassis, licorice, cedar and spiced oak.
