

Stefano Christiani 2016 Pinot Grigio

This Pinot Grigio is from the Alto Adige region of Northeastern Italy. This unique location, with its higher elevations and rolling vineyards, is considered superior to those of Val d'Adige, which are primarily on the valley floor.

Two main growing systems are used with the age of the vines ranging from 3-8 years on the modern Guyot system to 50 years on the traditional Pergola system. The vines are grown in sandy alluvial soil in the area between Margrè and Cortina, and in deep, loamy soils in the area of Salorno

Light green lusters run through the radiant straw-yellow color of this wine, whose aroma is rich in fruit, the most striking of which are pear and apple. An excellent balance gives this wine strength and structure. It is dry and smooth on the palate with a pleasant, mineral aftertaste. Pinot Grigio goes well with many dishes; especially lighter foods, fried mushrooms, and fresh water fish.
