Varietal: 100% Chardonnay

Appellation: 62% Sonoma Carneros, 38% Russian River

Alcohol: 13.5%

Aging: 76% tank fermented/aged, 24% barrel fermented and aged 18 months sur-lies

Aromas of green apple, pear, lemon zest and toasted oak. Fruit-forward flavors of honeydew melon and apple sauce. The mouthfeel is lush and creamy and has a balanced thread of acidity which presents the impression of sweet fruit.



2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

Varietal: 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc

Appellation: 100% California

Alcohol: 13.8%

Aging: 18 months in 15% New American, balance in French and American Neutrals

Aromas of blackberry and pomegranate with a hint of cedar and gunpowder on the nose. Plum, raspberry and a host of dark fruits on entry. There are medium weight tannins that pop up early in the midpalate and are accentuated with a solid core of acidity.



2014 Pinot Noir

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Appellation: 100% Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.6%

Aging: 18 months in mix of 1-year old French and older French neutral barrels

Pure Sonoma Pinot aromatics of bright red cherries with hints of cinnamon, cedar, and the slightest hint of tarragon. Very focused flavors of Jolly Rancher candy along with cranberry and various red fruits.

Alcohol: 13.6%

Aging: 29 months in 2-year old and neutral oak barrels

Aromatics of plum, blueberry, tobacco and anise with hints of vanilla and cedar. The first flavors you pick up are of concentrated strawberry and Rhubarb pie leading to tart cherry and a host of black fruits. The tannins are particularly lush and sweet, almost melting.
