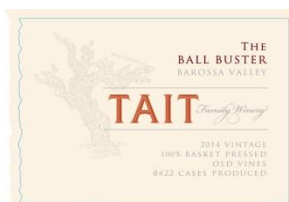

Blackberry, dark chocolate and spice aromas and flavors. Full and velvety.

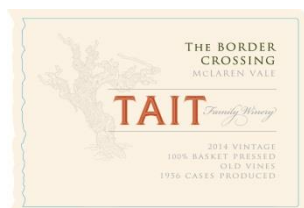
