

Bodegas Ordonez S.L. – Toro

Located in the town of Vallaester in the province of Zamaora, Toro is home to the highest concentration of ungrafted vines in Spain. The local indigenous grape, Tinta de Toro, is Spain's oldest and most original clone of Tempranillo, planted and cared for with the most traditional methods of viticulture.

Winemaking

Hand-harvested and stored in small baskets. Primary fermentation takes place in open top stainless steel fermenters with indigenous yeast. The wine is transferred to French oak and Burgundy Bordeaux barrels for malolactic fermentation.

Aging

8 months sur lie in French oak Burgundy and Bordeaux barrels with battonage.

Tasting Notes

Tinta de Toro is the pure representation of the oldest clone of Tempranillo in Spain, located in the only Spanish D.O. that completely resisted the phylloxera plague. The wine is rich and fruity characterized by smooth, integrated tannins and a long elegant finish.
